



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES

Please mail all application materials to Chamber of Flowood, P.O. Box 320927, Flowood, MS 39232

With the proceeds from their Annual Chili Cook-Off, the Chamber of Flowood is proud to award scholarships to three local high school seniors. Please review all information below before beginning the application process.

Eligibility

- Must be a high school senior graduating from one of the following schools: Hartfield Academy, Jackson Preparatory School, or Northwest Rankin High School.
- Must have cumulative GPA of 2.5 or more.
- Must demonstrate some level of financial need.
- Will be enrolled full-time (12 or more credit hours) in college for period covered by the proposed scholarship. There are no stipulations on which college the student plans to attend.
- Application must be complete and submitted by **March 20, 2023**. Mailed applications must be postmarked by March 17. See application form for more info on submission process.

Required Items

- ***The Chamber of Flowood Scholarship Application Form*** (follows)
 - Applications must be submitted on the standard form provided by the Chamber.
- ***Personal Essay***
 - Applicants will submit a 400-800 word essay (typed, double-spaced, Times New Roman, 12-point font, one-inch margins) answering each of the following prompts: **What have you done to improve your community (volunteer positions, jobs, passions in school, etc.)? What are your educational/career plans, and how will your future career and lifestyle impact the community in which you live? Please also include in your essay an explanation of your financial need for this scholarship.**
- ***Current Transcript***
 - Applicants should submit a high school transcript with ACT test scores.
- ***2 Letters of Recommendation*** (in sealed envelopes)
 - One letter from a teacher
 - One letter from a teacher, guidance counselor, coach, pastor, supervisor, or other qualified individual
 - Letters should be submitted with this application in a sealed envelope with the recommender's signature across the back flap of the envelope. Incomplete applications and applications without appropriate recommendation letters will not be considered.
